Circle Lake Information

There is NO on-site registration.

Completed registration form along with payment in full
MUST be received in the CCE Office by Oct. 1st

Persons registered for overnight accommodations may begin arriving at 4:00 p.m. on Friday.

Check out time will be Noon (from houses) and 2:00 p.m. (from property) on Sunday.

The cost includes all food and facility expenses. All meals will be provided.

Shared houses have fully equipped kitchens, including dishes and utensils.
Each house accommodates 8-12 persons and is furnished with beds of various sizes;
linens, pillows and blankets provided. A few portable cribs are available.
Three of the twelve houses are wheelchair accessible.

Things you NEED to bring:

Personal items; clothes, toiletries
Comfortable clothes and shoes
Food for special dietary needs

Things you CAN bring:

Recreational equipment & games
Fishing poles (bait houses on 249)
Swimsuits & towels (if pool's open)

Things you DO NOT need to bring:

Food, Money, Work, Bills, Worries

Directions to Circle Lake Retreat

From 45 N, take 249 W, past Tomball - staying on 249W, continue past Stagecoach Rd.
After the Citgo gas station on left – double lane, divided hwy. will narrow to one lane.

Directly after Baltzell Road, you'll see a street sign with Circle Lake on it on your right.

You will turn right onto Circle Lake, which is a dirt road that goes over a RR track.

(‘Kitchen’s Heating and Air’ on 249 is opposite the dirt road you’ll turn on.)

If you reach FM 149, you’ve gone too far!

The dirt road is lengthy and winding through a heavily wooded area.

You will end up at Circle Lake Retreat – well worth the drive!

More “FYI”

This retreat is being planned for persons with disabilities and their families.

**Our focus will be on the Gospel of Luke (19:1-10) ~ the parable of the tax collector Zacchaeus
and his determination to share his wealth and make amends.**

There will be times scheduled for prayer and reflection. There will be various group events and activities offered. Families will have choices for being together or apart for some activities. There will also be time allotted for participants to enjoy each other, make new and renew old friendships, and appreciate the beautiful surroundings on their own.
