

Who are the Helpers?

The Helpers of God's Precious Infants are a group of people committed to maintaining a loving and prayerful presence and witness outside the abortion sites where God's children are put to death.

- We pray to obtain God's mercy for the abortionist and his staff who do the killing.
- We witness to those who pass by, praying that they will take notice of what is going on and be moved to take action against the killing in their neighborhood.
- We pray for the lives of the babies and the pregnant women who have schedule appointments with the abortionist that day.
- We recognize the unborn as our brothers and sisters, welcoming them into the human family. We embrace them, spiritually. We stand with them when they die.
- We recognize the mother as our sister in Christ, who finds herself in a very difficult circumstance, offering the true alternative for herself and her baby, the love of Christ and his Church and all practical help needed.

The Helpers of God's Precious Infants is under the patronage of our Lady of Guadalupe.

The Aztecs offered annually at least twenty thousand men, women and children in human sacrifice to their gods. In one 4-day long ceremony eighty thousand captives were killed in human sacrifice but this was to change as their complete conversion to Our Lord was ensured by a "Lady from Heaven" who appeared to a poor Indian at Tepeyac, a hill northwest of Mexico City. She identified herself as the Mother of the True God, instructed him to have the bishop build a temple on the site and left an image of herself imprinted miraculously on his tilma, a poor quality cactus-cloth. The tilma which should have deteriorated within 20 years, still shows no sign of decay 476 years later and still defies all scientific explanations of its origin. The reflection in the eyes of Our Lady's image shows the room and it's occupants as when first revealed in 1531!

The Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe is celebrated on December 12th. In 1999, Pope John Paul II, in his homily from the Solemn Mass at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, during his third visit to the sanctuary, declared the date of December the 12th as a Liturgical Holy Day for the whole continent.

During the same visit Pope John Paul II entrusted the cause of life to her loving protection, and placed under her motherly care the innocent lives of children, especially those who are in danger of not being born.

How do the Helpers work?

- 1. Prayer** – Volunteers come to the abortion site for an hour or more praying in a spirit of reparation, for their own sins, the sin of abortion, for the abortionist and his staff, for the neighboring community, for the legislators, for the religious leaders of the nation, and for all who do nothing to stop abortion. Prayer provides essential spiritual and moral support for the Sidewalk Counselors as well as the grace of God that is needed to reverse the mother's 'spiritual abortion,' so she can accept her child.
- 2. Sidewalk Counseling** – Following in Our Lord's compassion, the trained sidewalk counselors offer true hope and real choices to those seeking an abortion. Counselors provide information that may help the mother to reconsider her decision but most of all to let her know that she is not alone.
- 3. Spiritual Support** – Spiritual supporters are present with the Helpers of God's Precious Infants through the Holy Spirit. They contribute prayers and sacrifices during the week, and offer them to God that His Will be done through the Helpers. The religious communities, called to a life of contemplation and prayer, provide powerful support for the Helpers.

What will the Helpers accomplish?

- Our purpose is to be faithful and pleasing to God and hope with God's help, to save the lives of God's precious infants through the spiritual conversion of their mothers.
- We also hope for ourselves to come closer to God through experiencing the mystery of His Cross, knowing Christ's personal love for each one of us, and the joy of responding to his call.
- We will learn to pray, offer penances, and abandon the results up to God. We will see that it is God's power and love which will overcome the evil of abortion and soften the hearts of those who participate.
