The **Biblical Studies Project** offers advanced Scripture study to adults who have completed Archdiocesan Old and New Testament courses or their equivalent.

These ten-hour courses are designed to focus on particular books of the Bible and are taught by instructors who have a specialty in Sacred Scripture. These courses are especially designed for those who lead Scripture study in parishes.

Since the content of the Biblical Studies Project will be offered at an undergraduate college level, a prerequisite will be completion of the Archdiocesan Old and New Testament courses or their equivalent. This means graduates of Formation Toward Christian Ministry or those who have completed the first semester of Formation Toward Christian Ministry are eligible to attend the Biblical Studies Project.

Biblical Studies courses can count towards one's catechist certificate as an elective or towards renewal of one's catechist certificate.

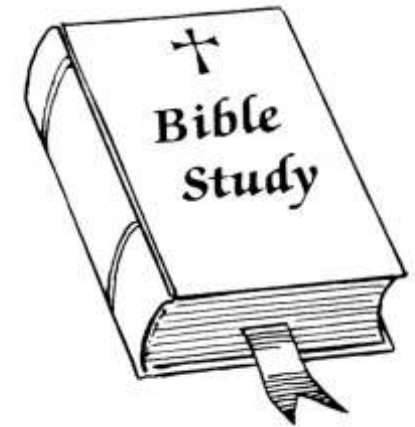
