

STEPS TO SUCCESS

STEP 1 – COMMIT

- Commit to forming youth of your parish as Missionary Disciples.
 - This requires a commitment to serving the poor and vulnerable.
 - Commit to bringing a certain number of teens and chaperones.
 - We recommend 4-8 teens with 1-2 adult chaperones or drivers.
 - The Key Leader does not have to be the Youth Minister.
 - You must provide enough drivers each day to transport your youth.

STEP 2 – REGISTER

- Go to www.archgh.org/oace and click on the English Cvent Links dropdown menu.
 - Register as the “Key Leader” for your parish.
 - Select the number of “guest” you will be bringing.
 - This is the number of teens and chaperones **not** including yourself.
 - You may modify this number until the registration deadline on 4/26/19.
 - A 10% deposit will be required at the time of registration.
 - i.e. – 5 participants is $5 \times \$160 \times 10\% = \80
 - Deposits are refundable until the registration deadline on 4/26/19.

STEP 3 – RECRUIT

- Be intentional about the teens you recruit for WITNESS.
 - General announcements and flyers are good but a personal invitation to a teen describing the program and inviting them is the most effective.
 - Every teen would benefit from WITNESS, don't limit your invitations to teens who love service projects.
 - Provide them with the registration packet (digital or hardcopy) including:
 - Flyer and Information Sheet | Mission Camp Schedule
 - Fundraising Ideas | Permission Slip and Liability Form

STEP 4 – PREPARE

- Prepare your teens by helping them fundraise and educating them about Catholic Social Teaching (sample night will be provided).
 - Prepare your teens and parents by hosting a pre-mission prayer night 2-4 weeks prior to WITNESS (sample night will be provided).
 - Prepare yourself by following the Key Leader WITNESS check list.

STEP 5 – SHARE

- After WITNESS, have your teens share their story with your parish at mass and at your next youth night. The most effective witnesses to other teens are their peers.
