Description

The **Music Coordinator** is a part-time (25 hours per week), hourly (non-exempt) member of the staff of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Community. This position is responsible for facilitating the worship life of the parish community by developing and implementing quality musical experiences. This position requires variable hours and on-call response after regular business hours to meet the musical needs of the parish during weekend, holiday and evening events. The Music Coordinator reports to the Associate Director of Music.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Assists in the development and implementation of the Parish music program, including musical accompaniment at assigned liturgical services and activities utilizing music.
2. Takes a lead musical role in assigned liturgical celebrations and parish events, per the direction of the Associate Director of Music
3. Assists in recruiting, training, and scheduling all persons involved in music ministries.
4. Assists in the management of the music budget & maintains the music library and files including the procuring of any copyright documents and other resources.
5. Assists in the periodic evaluation of the quality of the music ministry.
6. Coordinates the publishing of worship aids and other booklets as required.
7. Is competent in the operation of technological aids as required, such as projectors, audio/visual devices, microphones, sound equipment, etc.
8. Serves as leader of prayer when appropriate.
9. Is visibly present to main parish groups at principal parish events and is attuned to the living faith and real concerns of the parishioners.
10. Other duties as assigned.

Skills/Qualifications

1. A Bachelor's degree in music and/or liturgical music preferred.
2. Ability to work cohesively with staff, volunteers, and parish community.
3. Ability to utilize organizational skills in short and long range planning.
4. Knowledge and experience in sacred music and the sacramental practices of the Catholic Church, Liturgy, Traditions and rituals.
5. Experience and training in music teaching skills: both vocal and instrumental.
6. Proficiency in playing the keyboard or guitar.
7. A willingness to improve knowledge and skills through course-work and professional associations.
8. Practicing Catholic in good standing.
9. Fluent in English and Spanish, both written and verbal preferred.
10. Follows Archdiocesan Ethical and Personal Code of Conduct.
11. Favorable background check.
12. Physical ability to perform tasks associated with job.
