St. Christopher Catholic Church is seeking a Director of Music Ministry. This is a full-time, salaried position that offers benefits. The successful candidate must possess knowledge and understanding of Roman Catholic liturgy.

Duties & Responsibilities:

Working under the direct supervision of the Pastor, the music director plans and develops the entire parish music program, including selecting music appropriate for Catholic liturgies.

Provides music for Saturday/Sunday masses, special masses (Easter, Christmas, holy days of obligation, Confirmation, Wednesday school mass) and for funeral masses. Music services for other celebrations such as memorial masses, weddings and quinceaneras can be negotiated for additional stipends.

Coordinate and direct choir rehearsals for English and Spanish masses.

Must be proficient in multiple performance areas (vocal, piano, choral).

Must be able to organize liturgy/music binders for Priests, Deacons and acolytes for every mass.

Must be able to keep up with music department budget to include copyrights, licenses and song selection costs.

Qualifications:

Must be able to obtain satisfactory background clearance, adhere to all Archdiocesan policies and procedures and successfully complete the CMG Safe Environment training.

Bachelor's degree or equivalent professional music experience is required.

Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred, but not required.
