### **Primary Responsibilities:**

- The Director of Campus Ministry is responsible for facilitating ongoing faith development opportunities, focusing especially on discipleship and sustainable faith among all students, from the first moments of 9th grade, through their experience at St. Pius X.
- Moderating the Preachers Club, including logistics and accompaniment on extra-curricular service projects and weekly outings
- Coordinates School Liturgies and Daily Prayer
- Assists the Ministry team in retreat preparation, attends all retreats, certain conferences and mission trips. Supports student ministers responsible for designing and facilitating retreats.
- Maintain excellent communication, organizational and record-keeping skills, for multiple projects at a time, tracking programming details and logistics throughout the year.
- Engages the community to explore the scriptural foundation that calls us to justice and leads to service.
- Provides and coordinates opportunities for the school faith community to respond directly to the needs of the poor and suffering (i.e. special collections, disaster response, food and clothing drives, outreach experiences and immersions).

- Develops professional and pastoral relationships with local parishes, agencies, institutions, and individuals to provide ongoing direct service opportunities for the school faith community.
- Oversees and supervises the Service Learning and Social Justice course coordinated by the Associate Director for Campus Ministry.
- Promotes the knowledge, practice, integration and influence of Catholic Social Teachings within the mission and life of the school community.
- Collaborates with the Dominican Promoter of Justice, theology department chairs and members, faculty/staff, and other resource persons to explore and address the crucial social justice issues of our times.
- Perform other duties as deemed necessary by the Principal and/or Head of School

**Required Qualifications:**

- Commitment to embrace the Mission of St. Pius X High School.
- Bachelor's degree in theology, Pastoral Studies, or related field; advanced degree preferred.
- A minimum of two years' relevant experience preferred.
- Must show a demonstrated competency in multicultural, ecumenical, and interfaith issues.
- An ability to continue and advance the ecumenical and inter-religious understanding among students, faculty and staff on campus, and support all students in their own unique faith formation.
- An understanding of the spiritual/religious development stages for contemporary teenagers/young adults and the capacity to implement programs to meet these spiritual developmental aspirations
- Highly organized and reliable with demonstrated success working in quick-paced, dynamic environment with many responsibilities, ability to act efficiently on last minute projects.
