This full-time, benefits eligible position reports to the Director of Development and Stewardship, and is responsible for the creation and implementation of a comprehensive Stewardship formation and education program for parishes. This position supports development and stewardship activities of the Archdiocese at the downtown Chancery Offices of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston.

The Stewardship and Engagement Manager provides support of campaigns and events with a focus on efforts for that strengthen parishes and parishioner participation. This position has a significant role coordinating the annual Parish Stewardship and Engagement Conference, serves as liaison to the Stewardship Networking Group, creates Stewardship collateral materials and communications for departmental efforts, coordinates Stewardship speakers series, provides parish Stewardship planning consultation, and works to support the Archdiocesan Stewardship Advisory Council. In addition, the Manager will cultivate and solicit select donors.

Education/Experience Requirements:

Undergraduate degree with two to three years of applicable Development, Marketing, or Communications experience. Position requires exceptional oral and written communication skills with a proven ability to work well with volunteers and donors.
