- Must have excellent organization and communication skills.
- Intermediate to advance proficiency levels in Excel, Word, and PowerPoint software.
- Must have been in an administrative position requiring planning, budgeting, resource allocation, and goal setting.
- Must have the demonstrated abilities to motivate and dialogue with youth and parents.
- Must have the demonstrated abilities to work effectively in teams and other staff members.
