Cemetery Rules & Regulations

The following regulations are made in the best interests of all so that the Catholic Cemeteries will always be maintained in a manner befitting it's Holy purpose.

Visitation is permitted on the Cemetery grounds daily during daylight hours. No visitation is permitted after dark. Vehicles are to remain on the Cemetery paved roads at all times.

The following are **NOT** permitted on **Lawn Level (Flat) Marker graves**:
Fences, borders, trenches, plants, shrubs, metal or wood stakes/crosses/staffs, easels, statues, pictures, vigil lights, rocks/stones, glass or ceramic items, potted plants and/or any other items staked into the ground.

Bronze invertible vases are the only approved container for flowers on Lawn Level graves. If the vase is not a part of the marker it must be set into a concrete ring and placed at the head end of the marker. **Glass and ceramic vases are NOT permitted.**

The following are **NOT** permitted on **Upright Monument graves**:
Fences, borders, trenches, large plants or shrubs, metal or wood stakes/crosses, garden staffs, easels, vigil lights, rocks/stones, glass or ceramic items, other items staked into the ground. **Glass and Ceramic vases are NOT permitted.**

Statues are permitted as part of an erected monument. Small seasonal flowers are permitted to be planted within 24" of the front of the monument and must be enclosed in a solid border. Flowers may not be planted to the side or on the backside of a monument. The Cemetery will **NOT** be responsible for maintaining these plantings and reserves the right to remove unsightly plantings without notice. **Trees may NOT be planted without the express approval of the Cemetery.**

The Cemetery must approve **ALL** memorials.

Placing of personal items onto or into Cemetery trees is **NOT** permitted.

Unauthorized, faded or unsightly decorations or flowers will be removed without notice.

Holiday flowers/decorations are permitted 10 days prior to the holiday and must be removed 10 days after the holiday, except Christmas. Christmas decorations will be removed the first week in February. The Cemetery will remove any unsightly decorations without notice.

Temporary grave markers are permitted for 90 days. The Cemetery may permit the temporary marker to remain longer if a permanent marker is on order but not yet delivered. No temporary marker will be permitted to remain longer than 6 months from the interment date.

Alcohol is **NOT** permitted on Cemetery grounds at any time.
